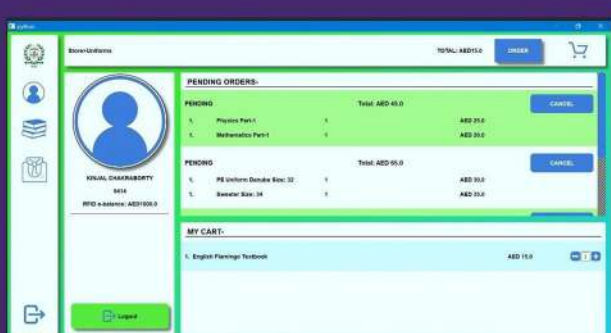
Education and Technology in UAE

Kinjal quips that it is a cumbersome process for students to queue up during the lunch break to collect books and uniforms eventually missing out of any productivity during the lunch hours. Sometimes the situation would compel students to take time off from their scheduled classes to collect these supplies. Such experiences have been the driving force for Kinjal and Parth to develop the app which will be a great help in managing time through a structured process.

The app allows browsing and facilitates ordering of books and uniforms through a user-friendly interface which ensures delivery of the product to the respective students in their classrooms. The app uses BookVerse for automated administrative tasks like managing pricing, stock management, order tracking, and receipt generation. The school IT cell is constantly working on the project to ensure better features in the coming days.
